The meeting was called to order at 4:45 p.m. by City Administrator/Clerk/Treasurer Audrey Fredrick. Present: Mayor Joe Johnston; Aldermen Lynn Burke, Dan Decker, Glenn Lantagne, Lisa Mattia and Don Shampo

Also present: Shannon Johnston

Excused: Alderman Mike Darne

Alderman Shampo moved to appoint Lisa Mattia to fill the open Council seat vacated by Alderman Joe Johnston. Lynn Burke seconded the motion. Motion carried.

City Administrator/Clerk/Treasurer Fredrick administered the Oath of Office to Mayor Joe Johnston.

City Administrator/Clerk/Treasurer Fredrick administered the Oath of Office to Aldermen Burke, Mattia and Shampo.

A motion was made by Alderman Decker and seconded by Alderman Lantagne to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Alderman Lantagne moved to elect Alderman Decker as the President of the City Council. Alderman Shampo seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Members of the Council were added to complete the list of Boards and Commissions. Alderman Decker moved to accept the appointments. Alderman Burke seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Alderman Burke made a motion to approve the Standing Committee list as presented. Alderman Lantagne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Alderman Shampo to designate the Borderland Journal/Florence Mining News as the official newspaper of the City. The Iron Mountain Daily News was designated as an alternate. Alderman Burke seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Alderman Decker moved to accept the offer from S.C. Swiderski LLC to purchase Industrial Park plats 11 and 12. Alderman Lantagne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Alderman Shampo moved to table the purchase of a replacement copy machine for the office until 2022. It will be added into the budget. Alderman Decker seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Alderman Decker to provide a monthly stipend of \$100.00 to the Mayor for supplies and mileage. Alderman Shampo seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Alderman Shampo moved to provide a monthly stipend of \$50.00 to the City Council President for supplies and mileage. Alderman Burke seconded the motion. Motion carried, with Alderman Decker abstaining from the vote.

A motion was made by Alderman Decker to set the City Council meetings on the fourth Wednesday of each month at 5:00 p.m. through April 2022. Alderman Burke seconded the motion. Motion carried.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Alderman Burke and seconded by Alderman Shampo to adjourn. Motion carried.
