The meeting was called to order at 12:00 p.m. by Mayor Bousley. Present: Mayor George Bousley, Aldermen Lynn Burke, Mike Darne, Larry Kuchinski and Glenn Lantagne Also present: Clerk/Treasurer Audrey Fredrick. Excused: Aldermen Dan Decker and Teresa West.

A motion was made by Alderman Kuchinski and seconded by Alderman Lantagne to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

There were no public appearances.

The Council reviewed a request from Nsight for the placement of fiber optic cable, which would necessitate the total closure of US Highway 141 during the 2020 construction project. The closure will be approved for one day, with an extra day to be granted if the fiber optic utility crew works from 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Traffic will be rerouted via an alternate route, which would include Hill Street, Forest Alley, Forest Street and Brook Street.

Alderman Kuchinski moved to support the request from Nsight. Alderman Lantagne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Alderman Lantagne and seconded by Alderman Darne to adjourn. Motion carried.
