

MINUTES
Budget Hearing

The meeting was called to order at 5:15 p.m. by Mayor Bousley. Present: Mayor Bousley, Aldermen Lynn Burke, Dan Decker, Glenn Lantagne and Don Shampo; Police Chief Angela Moreau, Public Works Coordinator Ron Rugg and Administrator/Clerk/Treasurer Audrey Fredrick.
Excused: Alderman Joe Johnston

A motion was made Alderman Lantagne to approve the agenda. Decker seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Administrator Fredrick verified that the notice of hearing was posted on October 28, 2020 in the Iron Mountain Daily News, as well as at mBank, Forward Financial Credit Union and City Hall. Alderman Decker moved to accept the verification of Notice of Public Hearing. Alderman Shampo seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Alderman Lantagne to open the public hearing at 5:20 p.m., and Alderman Shampo seconded the motion. Motion carried.

There were no public comments.

Administrator Fredrick verbally reviewed the key points of the budget, noting that the City total levy increased by \$20,000.00 from the previous year. The valuation increased, with the overall millage decreasing by approximately 0.12% (\$120.00 per \$100,000.00 of assessed value.)

Alderman Decker moved to close the public hearing at 5:37 p.m. Alderman Burke seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Alderman Burke moved to adopt the budget, and Alderman Shampo seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken, with all present voting "AYE". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Alderman Darne to close the budget hearing. Alderman Lantagne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:37 p.m.
