The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor George Bousley. Present: Aldermen Lynn Burke, Mike Darne, Dan Decker, Joe Johnston, Glenn Lantagne and Don Shampo; Police Chief Angela Moreau and Administrator/Clerk/Treasurer Audrey Fredrick.

A motion was made by Alderman Lantagne and seconded by Alderman Darne to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

There were no public appearances.

Police Chief Moreau stated that the existing speed limit ordinance SEC. 10-1-11 is not consistent with the signage. She recommended that the ordinance be amended to reflect a speed limit of 25 miles per hour on Highway 141 from a point .09 mile north of Dewey street southerly to the corporate limits of the City of Niagara, as this is a residential area. Alderman Lantagne moved to amend the ordinance. Alderman Darne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Alderman Decker moved to Adjourn to Closed Session Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statutes 19.85 (1)(c) – Personnel at 6:05 p.m.. Alderman Darne seconded the motion. A roll call attendance was taken, with all present. Motion carried.

Alderman Decker moved to reconvene to open session at 6:17 p.m. Alderman Shampo seconded the motion. A roll call attendance was taken, with all present. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Alderman Lantagne to amend the Waste Water Treatment Plant employee wage, effective January 1, 2021. Alderman Decker seconded the motion. Motion carried.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Alderman Decker and seconded by Alderman Lantagne to adjourn. Motion carried.
